

Evidence of identity information sheet for participants of high risk work licence assessments

Note:

- You are required to show the accredited assessor **original** evidence of identity (EOI) documents that add up to at least 100 points, certified copies will not be accepted
- The combination of EOI documents must contain your date of birth current residential address, photograph and signature at least once
- All documents provided must contain your name in full, not just your initials. The only exception is a council rates notice

Primary documents (70pts)

(Note: only one primary document can be provided)

Australian Birth Certificate/card issued by the Registrar of Births Deaths and Marriages	70pts
Passport – Australian or international (current or expired within last two years, but not cancelled)	70pts
Australian citizenship certificate	70pts

Secondary Documents (40pts)

Current Australian drivers licence or learner driver's licence/permit	40pts
Current Australian boat operators photo licence	40pts
Current NSW Firearms photo licence	40pts
Current Australian issued high risk work licence	40pts
Current Australia State/territory proof of age or photo card (eg a NSW RMS issued photo card)	40pts
Australian Police or Dept of Defence Card (with Photo)	40pts

Secondary Document (25pts)

Property (council) rates notice issued in the last (3 month)	25pts
Utility bills issued in the last (3 month)	25pts
Current Medicare Card	25pts
Telephone account issued in the last (3 months)	25pts
Current Centrelink Card	25pts
Current motor vehicle registration	25pts
Motor vehicle insurance papers	25pts
Department Veterans Affairs Card	25pts
Credit/Saving/Bank Statements issued in the last (3 month)	25pts
NOTE: If using credit/saving cards or statements (a maximum of 2 will be accepted) these must be from different financial institutions
